

Paw Protector Wax

Rodney lives in Canada, so he knows how snow, ice, and sidewalk salt can damage delicate paw pads. We love this wax for its soothing, healing, and protective qualities, and we recommend using it *before* a nasty ice storm hurts your dogs' paws. It also helps repel road salt. You can pour the wax into decorative tins, muffin liners, or mason jars, tie them up with a bow, and give them as great holiday gifts for the pups in your life.

Yields about 6 ounces

1 ounce beeswax
 3 tablespoons coconut oil
 3 tablespoons calendula oil
 3 tablespoons avocado oil
 10 drops lavender essential oil
Optional: calendula flowers

1. In a saucepan, combine beeswax, coconut oil, calendula oil, and avocado oil over low heat until melted.
2. Pour into a container.
3. Add calendula flowers and essential oil and stir gently.
4. Let cool.
