

## Coat Refresher Skin Spray

---

Use this spray between baths to freshen up your pet's stinky fur.

Yields 2–3 cups, depending on optional add-ins

½ cup apple cider vinegar

½ cup green tea

1 cup distilled water

*Optional:*

½ cup peppermint tea

½ cup calendula tea

5 drops lavender essential oil

1. Combine ingredients and mix well.
2. Pour into a spray bottle.
3. Shake well and spritz as needed to keep the coat refreshed.
4. Store mixture in the refrigerator for up to a month.

## Simple Eye Wash

---

Keeping your pet's eyes clean is a necessary way to remove irritants and allergens. Many pets have fur that contributes to eye irritation, and they rely on us to remove the debris that collects in the corners of their eyes. Once a day, if needed, you can use a damp clean cloth, pure colloidal silver, or a wash like this to disinfect and clean out any goop that's accumulated. If your pet *still* has eye boogers, apply a tiny dab of coconut oil where crust and discharge tend to accumulate; they'll come off like a breeze tomorrow.

Yields approximately ½ cup

¼ cup organic no-tears baby shampoo

¼ cup distilled water

1. Mix ingredients in a clean jar.
2. Add 1 teaspoon to a clean moistened washcloth or disposable cotton pad to gently clean the fur around the eyes. Repeat until all debris has been removed. Finish by wiping around eyes with pure water.
