Air purifiers with HEPA filters are more effective at cleaning indoor air pollution than any other kind of device, but they can be expensive (even up to \$1,000). We love this budget-friendly option for removing dust, pollen, chemicals, smoke, dander, and more.

20-inch box fan
20x20-inch pleated white furnace/HVAC air filter
(MERV-13 rating)
Clear packing tape

- Place the air filter squarely against the back of the fan.
- 2. Use the packing tape to secure the filter to the fan, on all sides, making sure there are no gaps.
- 3. Turn on the fan.
